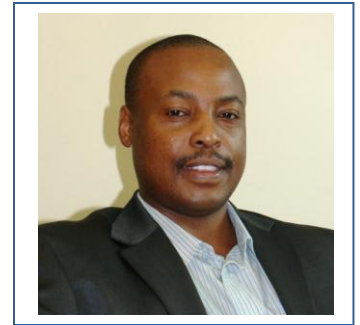


# MANAGEMENT PROFILE
